



Dade County Board of Commissioners Lowers 2025 Millage Rate

TRENTON, Ga. — In a decision that directly impacts every property owner in Dade County, the Board of Commissioners voted Wednesday to lower the county's 2025 millage rate following its third and final public hearing.

By majority vote, the Board adopted a **7.500 millage rate for unincorporated areas and 9.700 mills for incorporated areas**. This marks a reduction from last year's rates of 7.750 and 9.950, providing relief for taxpayers at a time when property values continue to rise.

"This is an important step in balancing the needs of county government with the responsibility we have to our citizens," said county officials following the vote.

The adoption follows a months-long process that included public advertisements and three public hearings, all required by state law to ensure transparency and citizen input.

Residents can expect to see the new rates reflected in their 2025 property tax bills, which will be issued this fall.
