



County Approval FY-2025 Budget Amendment with Sound Financial Oversight

TRENTON, Ga. (Sept. 9, 2025) — The Dade County Commission has approved Resolution R-37-25, making the official adjustment to the FY-2025 budget to accurately reflect final revenues and expenditures, including supplemental funds like the Sheriff's Fund, Drug Abuse and Education Fund, and ARPA allocations.

Chief Financial Officer Rebecca Jones explained how this amendment aligns with standard fiscal procedures:

- The fiscal year ended June 30, followed by a 60-day period for submitting late invoices or receipts.
- The amendment ensures all expenses and revenues are accounted for—including those from smaller specialized funds and ARPA—allowing transparent closure of the county's financial books.

The resolution passed quietly as part of the consent agenda, indicating full board support.

Looking ahead, the county's annual audit is scheduled for late September. This audit—required by Georgia law—must be completed within 180 days of the fiscal year-end and will be submitted to the State Department of Audits and Accounts.
