



January Commission Meeting Moved from New Year's Day to January 8, 2026

TRENTON, Ga. (Nov. 6, 2025) — The Dade County Board of Commissioners voted to change the date of its January 2026 regular meeting to avoid a conflict with the New Year's holiday and to ensure compliance with state open meeting requirements.

Resolution R-44-25, introduced by Chairman Don Townsend, officially moves the meeting from Thursday, January 1, 2026, to Thursday, January 8, 2026. The change ensures that county offices and staff are available following the federal holiday and that meeting notice requirements under the Georgia Open Meetings Act are properly observed.

“This adjustment is simply a matter of timing,” Townsend said. “We want to make sure that our staff and the public have an opportunity to attend the first meeting of the year without conflict.”

The Board’s January meeting will be held at 6 p.m. at the Dade County Administrative Building, with the regular session to follow immediately after the workshop.

Townsend noted that Dade County’s public meetings continue to be live-streamed and archived for residents who are unable to attend in person. All meeting dates, times, and agendas are posted in advance on the county’s website at www.dadecounty-ga.gov.

Resolution R-44-25 was unanimously approved and added to the November consent agenda for final adoption during the regular meeting.
