



Commissioner Hartline Reports on Electrical Inspections and Sports Complex Improvements

TRENTON, Ga. (Nov. 6, 2025) — Commissioner Phillip Hartline presented updates on electrical inspections, new construction activity and progress at the Dade County Sports Complex during the November regular meeting.

Commissioner Hartline reported that 30 electrical inspections were completed in October, following 31

conducted in September. Six new construction temporary poles were recently installed, indicating additional home starts across the county. He also noted the installation of five new meter bases that will support 19 planned yurts in a developing lodging area.




At the Sports Complex, irrigation systems for the baseball, soccer and football fields have been winterized, and seasonal leaf maintenance is underway. The restroom facility near the maintenance shop has been closed for the winter due to the lack of heat, while remodeling work on the middle restroom is scheduled to begin soon. New toilets, urinals and sinks are expected to be installed before spring sports resume.



Commissioner Hartline also reported ongoing construction of the new storage building at the complex. The walls are in place and the concrete floor has been poured. The next phase of the project will include pumping concrete into the wall forms and installing the roof.

The Board of Commissioners will continue receiving monthly updates on facility maintenance, construction activity and county inspection services.
