



Commissioner Bill Pullen Reports on Bridge Projects, Power Upgrades, and Emergency Services Activity

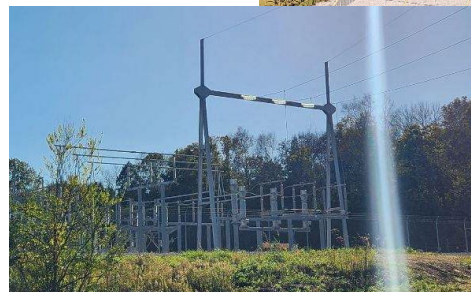
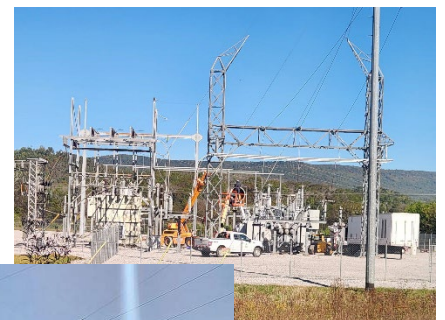
TRENTON, Ga. (Nov. 6, 2025) — Commissioner Bill Pullen delivered an infrastructure-focused report during the November regular meeting, outlining ongoing bridge work, utility improvements and monthly emergency services activity.

Dr. Pullen reported substantial progress on the Squirrel Town Creek bridge on U.S. Highway 11, where the floor bases, walls and guardrails have been completed. Crews are currently working on the bridge approaches, and the temporary structure will be removed as the project moves into its next phase.



He also detailed preparation work for the upcoming Slygo Road bridge replacement, a Georgia Department of Transportation project that will require an extended closure once construction begins. A new turnaround has been constructed for school buses, and clearing work has begun along the site in anticipation of the bridge's demolition and reconstruction.

Commissioner Pullen highlighted Georgia Power's ongoing upgrades at the Morganville substation, where crews have replaced wooden poles with larger steel structures and installed additional transmission capacity. The improvements are designed to strengthen electrical service to Hooker, Sand Mountain and parts of Trenton and support long-term grid reliability in the northern end of the county.





In community updates, Commissioner Pullen attended a ribbon-cutting event for Mom's Monster Cookies, noting the addition of new local businesses and amenities available to residents.

He also reviewed October's emergency services statistics. Stations 1 and 4 continued to report the highest call volumes, and overall, 911 activity reached 2,311 calls for the month. EMS responses included combined activity from Memorial and Dade County EMS. No coroner calls were recorded.

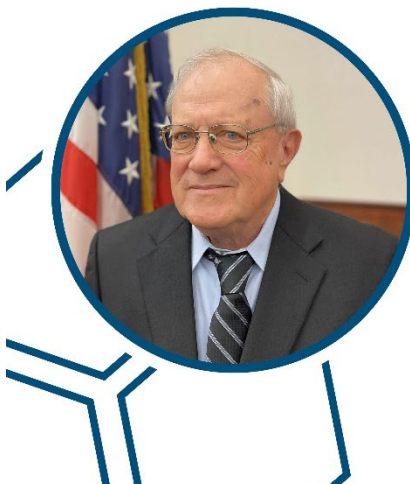
The Board of Commissioners will continue receiving monthly public safety and infrastructure updates as these projects progress.
